



AUTHOR'S SNAPSHOT - PROFESSOR MYRNA S. FELICIANO

Prof. Feliciano is a pioneer in legal and judicial education; judicial reform and rights of women and children. She is professor of law at the University of the Philippines College of Law, and was the Director of the University of the Philippines Law Centre Institute of Judicial Administration (IJA). The IJA conducts continuing legal education programs for members of the bar. Before the Philippine Judicial Academy was established, the IJA also assisted the Supreme Court in providing continuing education programs for judges and court personnel and other projects aimed to improve the administration of justice in Philippine courts.

Prof. Feliciano is now Chair of the Philippines Judicial Academy's (PHILJA) *Department of Legal Method and Research* and a Member of PHILJA's Academic Council. She is an active proponent of mandatory continuing legal education and women and children's rights, and has held the roles of:

- Commissioner of the National Commission on the Role of Filipino Women (NCRFW);
- first Executive Director of the Mandatory Continuing Legal Education (MCLE) Committee of the Supreme Court; and
- Member of the Rules Committee on Family Courts formed by the Supreme Court.

A recognised judicial reform expert, Prof. Feliciano has consulted extensively in projects funded by the European Commission, multilateral development banks and international aid institutions and published voluminous works on legal and judicial education; judicial reform and rights of women and children, among others.

Prof. Feliciano has obtained Bachelor of Science and Bachelor of Law degrees from the University of the Philippines. She also holds a Masters degree in Library Science from the University of Washington and a Master of Laws degree from Harvard University.
