Mr Hari Phuyal is an advocate in the Supreme Court of Nepal and works as a lawyer to the International Commission of Jurists (ICJ). He is contributing to the Nepal Bar Association to develop its stand on the independence of the judiciary in the up-coming Constitution through the Constituent Assembly.

He has LL.M. from the University of Essex, the UK and National Law School of India University, Bangalore, India. He has worked as the National Legal Adviser to the Office of the High Commissioner for Human Rights (OHCHR) in Nepal and has worked for the National Human Rights Commission, Nepal.

His work with the Nepal Bar Association, was as an Executive Editor of the Bar's magazine *NYAYADOOT*. Mr Phuyal is the author of a book on *Refugee Law* as a course book to LL.B students in Nepali language, and he has also taught a number of law courses to students of Bachelor of Law at Tribhuban University, Kathmandu.

Mr Phuyal was contributing author to a book on *Police and Human Rights*, as well as to the *Handbook of International Humanitarian Law in South Asia*, written with Professor Dr. Surya Subedi (edited by V.S. Mani, Oxford University Press, 2007.) He also contributes to both the Law Journal published in Nepal, and contemporary papers.
